Supplies:

- Scissors
- Glue
- Crayons
- Paints
- Food coloring mixed with water
- Newspaper (protect your workspace)

Inspiration to get you started:

- Sculpture or picture of: birds, endangered animal, invention to help the earth
- Earth Day poster
- Self-portrait collage made of recyclables

Reusable Recyclables:

- Cardboard
- Old artwork to cut up
- Old Letters and envelopes
- Used Postage stamps
- Junk mail
- Coffee filters (used and rinsed out)
- Coffee Sleeves (cardboard around coffee cup)
- Used wrapping paper
- Wrapping paper tube
- Toilet paper roll cardboard tubes
- Egg cartons
- Magazines to cut up
- Old photographs
- Cereal and snack boxes (colorful outsides/cardboard insides to draw or paint)
- Paper grocery bags
